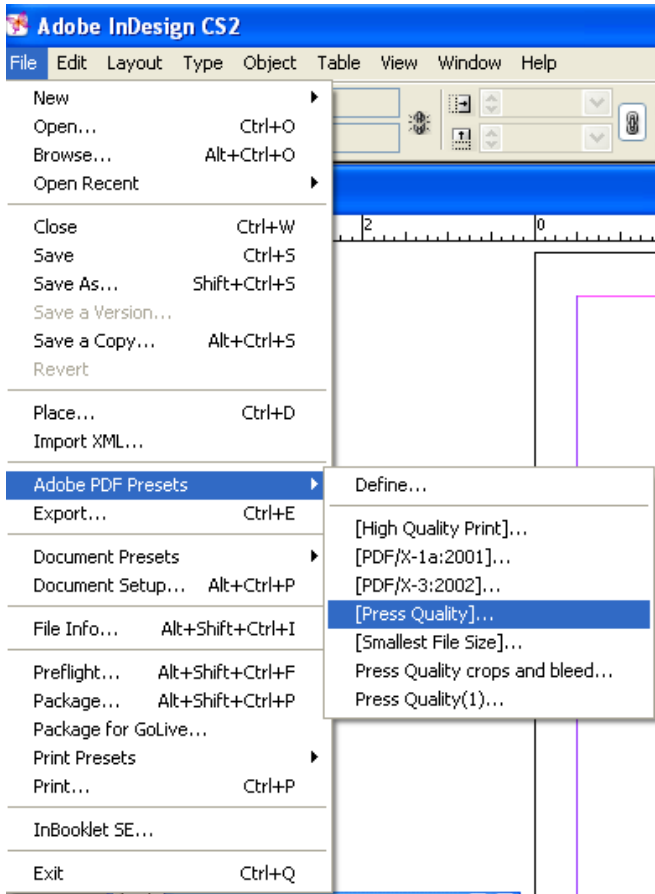
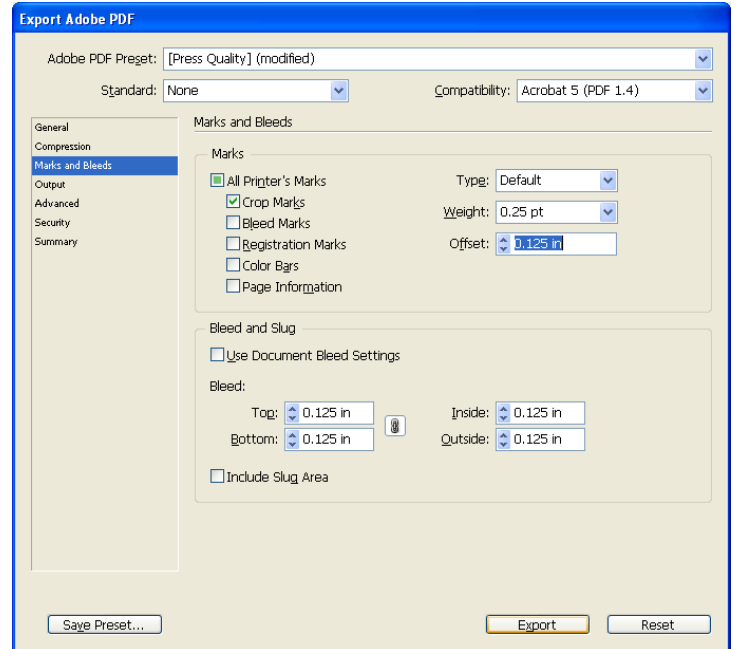


Creating a PDF from Adobe InDesign

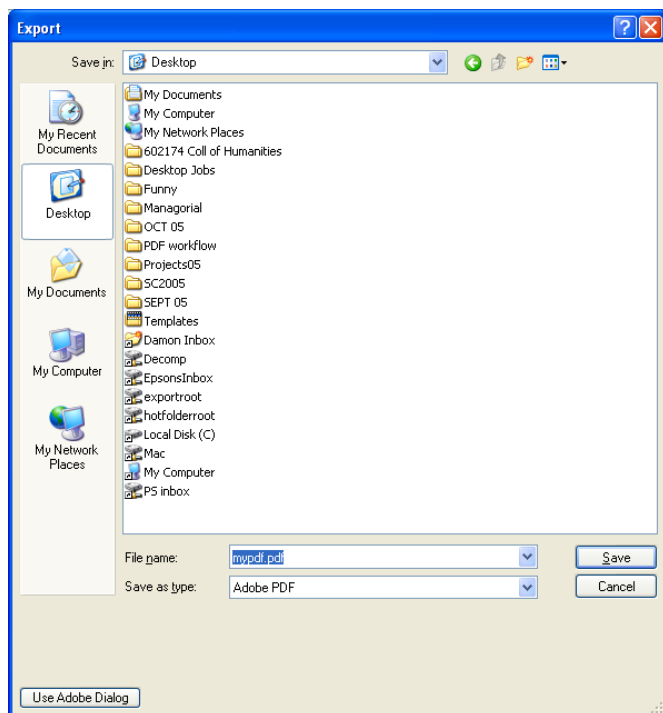
Open InDesign file and select File, Adobe PDF Presets, and select Press Quality.



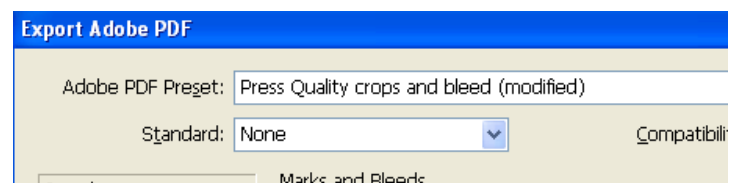
At the top of the window under Adobe PDF Preset, it should read Press Quality. Click export to save the pdf. If you have designed your document to bleed you must utilize the Marks and Bleeds option as shown.



Name the file and click save.



Utilize the Save Preset function located at the bottom of the window to save a custom preset. Now every time you have a job that bleeds you can select that preset you have custom named.



Please select View PDF after Saving to ensure the PDF you have created is correct. This can also be saved in the custom preset.
